

STUDENT PLACEMENT ORIENTATION AT NORTH EASTERN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

- Students to present at the front reception at 09.00 on the first day of placement and ask for Clinical Educator.
- Students to present current National Police Check, DHS Screenings and competed Manual Handling, CPR, Hand Hygiene, BloodSafe and Infection Control certificates on the first day along with evidence of your COVID vaccine
- Rosters for placement to be agreed on with the Department Manager and Student car parking is available on the streets surrounding the Hospital/ Aged Care Facility
- Staff can purchase lunch from the kiosk or through the hospital kitchen
- Student ID badges to be worn at all times
- Student to complete and provide copy of completed orientation to the Clinical Manager by the end of the first day
- Facilitators name and contact details to be provided to the Clinical Manager
