This combined degree requires the completion of a total of 153 units with a grade of P or NGP or better in each topic (34x 4.5-unit topics). The BBSC component requires completion of 94.5 units, and the BA component requires completion of 58.5 units.

Students must select two different majors:

- The BBSC Major must be chosen from the <u>list of majors</u> available in the Bachelor of Behavioural Science (Psychology) course rule, and students must ensure they complete the 8 topics required for that major.
- The BA Major must be chosen from the <u>list of majors</u> available in the Bachelor of Arts course rule, and students must ensure they complete the 8 topics required for that major. Students may not select Psychology as their BA Major.

Core topic pre-requisites are noted in red. Students must have passed the listed pre-requisite topics/units to proceed with their enrolment.
