3. 9 units of **first year elective topics** chosen from topics offered in the Bachelor of Arts
4. **A major (36 units) or a minor (18 units)** in a language or allied discipline from the list below (*Second language must be different to the first language major chosen*):  
 French, Indonesian, Italian, Modern Greek, Spanish, Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) (*minor only*), Applied Linguistics, Creative Writing, English, University of Adelaide Languages: Chinese, German, Japanese
5. Either 9 or 27 units **option topics** to make a total of 108 units
