
This guide shows HDR students how to further improve your profile, and the effect on the ResearchNow Portal.

#### Process



#### Steps

- 1. Login to ResearchNow.
- 2. Navigate to Personal tab on top menu bar
- 3. Select *Edit profile*... A pop-up appears.
- 4. Select Portal profile in the left-hand pane.



1. You can modify three elements of your portal profile: *Show collaboration map on profile*, *Show affiliations* and *Show metrics*. These provide dynamic displays of your collaborations and institutions and your research output metrics (H index and citations),



# ResearchNow

By default the collaboration map is turned on, the affiliation is set to your primary organization unit and the metrics are visible

- 5. Select *Highlighted content* in the left left-hand pane.
  - Select the tab of the content type to highlight content from. NOTE: At the moment there is only one usable tab (Research outputs) but in future other options will be added.
  - 2. Select the + icon to open a search bar.

- 3. Type in the search bar for content.
- 4. Choose the correct item by selecting on the list.
- 5. Reorder publications by using the arrow buttons.
- Remove items using the (minus) button.

- 6. Select Save at the bottom of the pop-up.
