Recommended Full Academic Load at Exchange Universities for Full Flinders Credit

(As at November 2017)

The following table is a guide for College advisors and students about the points or credits required to achieve the equivalent of a standard full load at Flinders per semester. It is based on historical approvals and is continually updated so should be used as a predictor of future credit arrangements. Inconsistencies should be brought to the attention of the International Centre-Learn Without Borders Team. This information is primarily for Undergraduate students. Loads may vary for Postgraduate students.

While on exchange you must retain a full time enrolment status at Flinders (no less than 13.5 units per semester) and register for a standard full-time academic load at your host university. Your enrolment at your host university must be in units which count for at least 18 Flinders units (per semester), unless otherwise approved.

Any variation to this requires approval from your College before going on exchange.

Do not assume that 4 topics at your host university is equivalent to 4 Flinders topics.

Please note that the host universities use different terminology to that used at Flinders. Topics may be called the following: Courses, Modules, Units, Subjects, Papers.

Points may be called the following: Units, Credits, Credit Hours, ECTS (European Credit Transfer System).

The relevant College will make the final decision on the equivalent full load acceptable at your host university.
